- ✓ Student activities and access to SFUAD gym, library, tennis courts.

*Each LIU institution is responsible of planning the extracurricular activities during the workshop.*

Requirements: Students with basic level of English; in good academic standing, being selected by the LIU University to participate in the workshop; students take a placement test at home university prior to applying. Each group of 15 students must be accompanied by a coordinator.



## English & Visual Arts High School Students
